DISCUSSION AND STUDY

ICE BREAKER QUESTION – If you could live in any country, which country would you pick?

SCRIPTURE DISCUSSION AND STUDY

INTRO – Jesus triumphantly entered Jerusalem as God's appointed King riding on a donkey to fullfill Old Testament prophecy.

*This week's sermon focused on baptism. These questions are focused on John's account of the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem as we prepare for Easter.

READ – John 12:12-19

QUESTION – What was the crowd's expectation of Jesus?

QUESTION – How did Jesus's act of riding on a donkey challenge the crowd's idea of leadership and power? What did this reveal about Jesus' character and mission? How does this challenge your idea of leadership and power?

QUESTION – In verse 16, John tells us that the disciples did not understand what was happening to Jesus at the time, but later understood the significance. Describe a time from your life when you initially struggled to comprehend a situation, only to later discern how it aligned with God's plan. How does this insight influence your trust and faith in God's timing and purposes?

QUESTION – According to verses 17 and 18, what specific group of people were mentioned as being a part of the crowd? Why do you think they were there?

QUESTION – Describe the Pharisees reaction to Jesus being praised by the crowd. Why were they upset at Jesus' increasing popularity?

QUESTION – How does this event fulfill Old Testament prophecy (read Zechariah 9:9 and Psalm 118:25-26)? How does this give you confidence in God and His word?
