ICE BREAKER QUESTION – What's one thing your parents constantly nagged you about?

SCRIPTURE DISCUSSION AND STUDY

INTRO – In this passage, Paul encourages us to walk in wisdom and be filled with the Holy Spirit.

READ – Ephesians 5:15-21

QUESTION – In verse 15, Paul tells us to "look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise". According to Proverbs 13:20, what is one way to gain wisdom? Can you think of any other ways to walk wisely according to the Bible?

QUESTION – Paul then tells us to "make the best use of the time". How do you spend your time? How can we actively take advantage of opportunities to do good?

QUESTION – What is God's will for all believers? (Read Romans 8:29)

QUESTION – What two commands are stated in verse 18? What are the results of being filled with the Spirit listed in verse 19-21?

QUESTION – Verse 19 tells us to "address one another in psalms, hymns, spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart". Who are we singing to? How does this effect your view of corporate worship?

QUESTION – Paul says when we are filled with the Spirit, we will submit "to one another out of reverence for Christ". Who is our motivation for submission to one another?

QUESTION – How does remembering that believers are saved only because Jesus submitted to God's will shape your view on submission?
